2324/149 Introduction from the Chair

Cllr White welcomed all to the meeting.

2324/150 Public Participation

Several members of the public were present. There was also a presentation by Sophie Brandon from the University of Leeds in relation to Gair Wood. She advised that 66,000 trees had been [planted to help with bio diversity and climate change. Once the trees have matured there is a proposal for a permissive right of way and public access. At this stage the survival rate for the trees stands at 85%. Members thanked her for the presentation.

Separately it was agreed to ensure minutes from previous meeting were placed on the Council's website.

Councillor Illingworth presented a report after meeting with Mark Atkinson from Leeds City Council. He had conducted a straw poll with local residents using the path resulting in 52 in favour of the lights and 2 against. He advised each light would cost £11k thus totaling £77k although this would ensure a lifetime investment as Leeds City Council would continue to maintain them after installation. After some discussion it was agreed that further consideration should be given to the project and Councillor Wright would continue the process with Councillor Illingworth.
